Dear Homeowner,

We are excited to be starting the fall tree planting project for our community. As a refresher, we will be installing 80 Ivory Silk Lilac trees – one approximately every 50 feet between the sidewalk and street. The scheduled work will be done in several stages beginning as follows:

Week of September 23rd

- Call Before you Dig will be marking utility lines
- Meyer’s Landscaping will put flags out where each tree should be planted

Month of October

- Residents will have an opportunity to address modest changes to the placement with the HOA Board. Contact Jennifer Betts at Jennifer.sherman.betts@gmail.com

Month of November

- Once trees are dormant they will be harvested and replanted by Meyer’s Landscaping.

Additional Details

- Fairways HOA to provide maintenance / trimming of trees.
- Soil amendments, starter fertilizer, dark hardwood mulch and deer guards included.
- 1 year warranty included by Meyer’s Landscaping
